



Possible service disruption at Legal Services Society

The Legal Services Society today received 72-hour strike notice from the BCGEU representing LSS support, technical and professional (non-lawyer) staff. This entitles the union to go on strike at noon Monday, July 26. Details of what actions, if any, the union intends to take have not been provided.

In the event of a labour disruption, the Legal Services Society will do its best to ensure that services remain available to assist clients and the tariff bar. Further information about any impact on services will be distributed as necessary.

The Legal Services Society remains committed to reaching an agreement with the BCGEU through the collective bargaining process and continues to be available to resume negotiations.
