

Holdbacks – Effective July 1, 1999

Holdback Policy

The date of assignment of a referral determines which holdback applies. (The date of assignment may be found at the top of the referral form) Please refer to the chart below to determine the holdback amount for a particular referral.

Immigration

October 1, 1993 – June 30, 1994	reduction	3.2%
July 1, 1994 – July 31, 1994	holdback	22.5%
August 1, 1994 – March 31, 1995	holdback	12%
April 1, 1995 – April 30, 1997	holdback	12%
May 1, 1997 – June 30, 1999	holdback	17%
July 1, 1999 – until further notice	holdback	10%

Criminal

October 1, 1993 – June 30, 1994	reduction	4.3%
July 1, 1994 – July 31, 1994	holdback	22.5%
August 1, 1994 – August 31, 1994	holdback	15%
September 1, 1994 – March 31, 1995	holdback	10%
April 1, 1995 – April 30, 1997	holdback	10%
May 1, 1997 – June 30, 1999	holdback	15%
July 1, 1999 – until further notice	holdback	10%

Family & CFCSA

October 1, 1993 – June 30, 1994	reduction	1%
July 1, 1994 – July 31, 1994	holdback	22.5%
August 1, 1994 – September 30, 1994	holdback	10%
October 1, 1994 – March 31, 1995	holdback	5%
April 1, 1995 – April 30, 1997	holdback	5%
May 1, 1997 – until further notice	holdback	10%

Appeals

Referrals made from the Appeals department at LSS head office were subject to the *reductions* in each of the areas of law for the period October 1, 1993 – May 1, 1997. Referrals made for the period May 1, 1997 – January 1, 1999 were subject to 5% holdbacks. Appeals cases are subject to the following holdbacks:
