Dear Allan Seckel:

I write to communicate my approval of Legal Aid BC's (LABC) revised 2024/25 Budget Management Plan (BMP) as submitted on April 8, 2024, reflecting budget decisions and directives received on Budget Day, assuming we have a common understanding and agreement on the following points:

- 1. The Federal government is responsible for funding the delivery of Immigration and Refugee (I&R) legal aid services and I understand that status quo funding levels announced in Federal Budget 2024 may not be sufficient in meeting the forecasted demand for I&R legal aid across Canada.
  - Although LABC does not intend to implement any service reductions in the immediate term, I trust that you along with LABC staff will continue to work with the Department of Justice to monitor risks and examine options as the year progresses.
- 2. I note that LABC's three-year budget includes proposals for increased revenues for the Mental Health Law Program and Prisoners Legal Services starting in fiscal 2026/27.
  - My approval of your BMP is only based on confirmed revenues for the next three years. As such, there can be no expectation of increased provincial revenues for these programs.
