



User Agreement for *The Bottom Line* Digest

Legal Aid BC (LABC) is authorized to distribute *The Bottom Line* in Refugee Law, a publication of Legal Aid Ontario's LAO LAW service, to immigration and refugee lawyers who accept legal aid referrals from LABC.

The Bottom Line is a weekly digest of summaries of immigration and refugee law cases.

LABC will only distribute *The Bottom Line* to authorized users. An authorized user is a lawyer who:

- is in good standing with the Law Society of British Columbia,
- holds an active LABC vendor number,
- currently accepts immigration and refugee legal aid referrals, and
- agrees to the Terms of Use set out below.

Terms of Use for *The Bottom Line*:

- The authorized user may save or print single copies of *The Bottom Line* for their personal use *only* for research on specific legal aid funded cases;
- The authorized user **may not**, either manually or by electronic or automated means, redistribute or otherwise provide copies of materials to other people or information systems, including other lawyers; and
- The authorized user agrees that LABC will provide his or her name and contact information to LAO LAW for their monitoring purposes.

Failure to abide by these Terms of Use will result in removal from the distribution list.
