

Repayment of Holdbacks

The Board of Directors of Legal Services Society has reviewed the audited financial statements for LSS's 1995-96 fiscal year. Holdbacks were applied to tariff accounts in that year and were to be considered for repayment if the expenditures in a particular tariff were less than the projected budget for that period.

Criminal, family, and immigration tariff expenditures exceeded the budgets projected for each of those tariffs for the fiscal year 1995-96. Therefore, no holdbacks deducted on criminal, family, or immigration tariff referrals in 1995-96 will be repaid.

The holdbacks in each of the three tariffs have been extended by the Board of Directors until further notice. Consideration of whether any amounts will be repaid from the amounts held back in the fiscal year 1996-97 will be made when the Board of Directors receives the audited financial statements in the fall of 1997.
